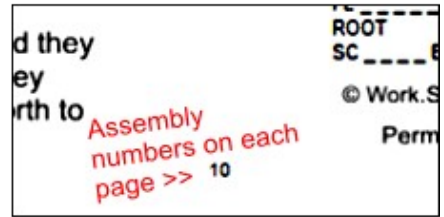


## Modest Booklet Binding



If you have a standard stapler,

1. assemble the pages according to table and crease them.
2. lightly fold over the corner of the BACK half of the pages. Be careful not to crease the angular fold.
3. Move the stapler as far down the page as possible, before stapling. One staple should be sufficient.



### Assembly number table:

1 goes on the flip side of 2

3 goes with 4

5 goes with 6

7            8

9            10

11          12



If no stapler is available,

1. assemble the pages according to the table and crease them.
2. use scissors to create two SMALL V-notches at least 4 inches apart.
3. to minimize the size of notches needed, a hair pin can be used like a needle to feed the brightly colored yarn through the notches.



4. Tie the yarn in a secure knot, and then finish with a bow.
5. A small drop of clear glue on the bow knot would be a good idea.
6. You may wish to do a bit to personalize a couple of the pages by having a small person, WITH SUPERVISION, add a few simple symbols to a page or two.
